before moving to St. Cloud, MN, and worked for Anderson Trucking Service as a heavy-duty truck mechanic for a number of years. From ATS he went to work for International Harvester in St. Cloud as a heavy-duty mechanic and later as shop foreman for 11 years. He then went to work for Harold Anderson at Cold Spring Granite Co. In the parts dept. as a clerk and later transferred to the M&W office to operate a computer in charge of ISO and machine maintenance records and retired in March of 1998.
