They were blessed with three boys: Craig, Terry, and Curtis. Bob attended Simpson College and the family later moved to California for four years where he graduated with a business degree from Fullerton College. Upon

returning to Newton, Bob worked at the Vernon Company, Dunlap Manufacturing, part-time at Coast to Coast, and then at the Maytag Company, where he would retire from, as a supervisor. Bob was a member of the First United Methodist Church, the American Legion Post 111, the American Legion Post 111 Honor Guard, Newton Booster Club, and the American Quarter Horse Association. He was an avid sports fan cheering on the Chicago Cubs and the Iowa Hawkeyes. He also was a booster and supporter of the Newton Nitehawks. Bob enjoyed sprint car racing, horse racing, and rose gardening.
