Henry was born on July 15, 1923 to Theodore and Martha (Ohlenbusch) Schwarz in Pyron, Texas. He attended school in Hobbs, Texas and graduated from Texas Tech University with a degree in Agriculture. Henry worked at Tech to help develop the technology of artificial insemination of dairy and beef cattle. He was a well-respected technician in this part of Texas, offering artificial insemination services, as well as classes to ranchers and dairymen. He was also a long-time farmer in the Veribest community. Henry proudly served his country during World War II, first as a bugler, then as an instructor for recruits in marksmanship. He reached the rank of Staff Sergeant, and received an honorable discharge before resuming and completing his college education. On June 27, 1948, he married the love of his life, Jo Nita Callan, in Hobbs, Texas. Henry and Jo Nita lived in in the Veribest community for 50

years and remained married for an astounding 68 years. Henry was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church in Miles, American Legion Post 32 in San Angelo, and a Life Member of DAV.
